**ORDINANCE NO. 226**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAKE MINNETONKA  
CONSERVATION DISTRICT CODE OF ORDINANCES**

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LAKE MINNETONKA CONSERVATION DISTRICT  
ORDAINS:

**Article I. Adoption by Reference.** Chapter I, Section 1.03, Subd. 3 of the LMCD Code is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

Subd. 3. Adoption by Reference. The full text of the most current versions of the Minnesota Statutes and Minnesota Rules adopted by reference in this Code shall be treated as though they were set out in full herein and are made part of this Code. Those statutes and rules adopted by reference include any amendments made thereto and any successor provisions. The adoption by reference of specific statutes and rules shall also include the adoption of such other statutes and rules that are needed to give full effect to those provisions expressly adopted by reference.

**Article II. Noise.** Chapter I, Section 3.01, Subdivision 17 of the LMCD Code is hereby amended by adding the double-underlined material and deleting the ~~stricken~~ material as follows:

Subd. 17. Noise. No person shall operate any watercraft or boat, other than an aircraft, on the Lake in a manner that exceeds the noise limits contained in Minnesota Statutes, Section 86B.321, which is hereby adopted by reference and incorporated herein. ~~which is capable of exceeding a noise level on the A scale measured at a distance of 50 feet or more from the watercraft or boat of:~~

- a) ~~80 decibels in the case of marine engines or motorboats; or~~
- b) ~~79 decibels in the case of personal watercraft wat jet pump engines manufactured after January 1, 1992.~~

**Article III. Watercraft Safety Rules.** Chapter III, Section 3.03 of the LMCD Code is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

Section 3.03. Watercraft Safety Rules and Rules of the Road. All watercraft operating on the Lake must at all times be in compliance with the safety and operating requirements in Minnesota Rules, part 6110.1200, which is hereby adopted by reference and incorporated herein.

**Article IV. Watercraft Equipment.** Chapter III, Section 3.04 of the LMCD Code is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it with the following:

Section 3.04. Watercraft Equipment and Rules. All watercraft operating on the Lake must at all times be in compliance with the equipment requirements of Minnesota Rules, part 6110.1200, which is hereby adopted by reference and incorporated herein.

**Article V. Incorporation of Amendments.** The LMCD Attorney and staff are hereby authorized and directed to incorporate the amendments made by this Ordinance into the LMCD Code and such updated version shall constitute the official Lake Minnetonka Conservation District Code of Ordinances.

**Article VI. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall be effective the day following its publication or a summary thereof.
