SUBJECT: 8/12/11 AIS Task Force Meeting

The next AIS Task Force Meeting has been scheduled for Friday, August 12<sup>th</sup>. Co-Chairs Herb Suerth and Kelsey Page have scheduled a working tour by pontoon to view the 2011 coordinated herbicide treatments on Carmans and Phelps Bays, with a short Task Force meeting to follow at the Hennepin County Sheriff's Water Patrol Headquarters.

The following details are provided:

- **Location of Departure:** Spring Park Bay Public Access (located east of the Water Patrol Headquarters at 4141 Shoreline Drive). Please note that parking is limited within the public access and you might need to park at the overflow lot to the east off of County Road 15 (see attached map for details).
- **Time of Departure:** 8:30 a.m. with a planned completion time of 10 a.m.
- **RSVP:** Please RSVP to the LMCD office by 12 NOON on Tuesday, August 9<sup>th</sup> as to whether you plan on attending. Please note that seating is limited on the pontoon and that first priority will be given to AIS Task Force members. In the event that no public seating is available on the pontoon, the public is welcomed to participate in the working tour from their own watercraft, as well as participate in the follow-up AIS Task Force meeting at the Water Patrol Headquarters.
- **Follow-up AIS Task Force Meeting:** Hennepin County Sheriff's Water Patrol Training/Conference Room. The Task Force will reconvene 10 minutes after returning to the public access. Length of this meeting is estimated to be 30 to 60 minutes.
