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- Each of the combined riparian sites is occupied by one single family residential structure.
- All of the restricted watercraft stored at the facility are owned by and registered to persons who live in the single family residential structures on the combined sites.
- The dock structure has a single point of entry from the shoreline.
- All of the combined sites have at least 20 feet of shoreline at elevation 929.4 NGVD.
- No more watercraft may be stored at the combined site than can be practically and validly stored at the uncombined sites including consideration of side setback requirements at the uncombined sites.
- The dock structure and watercraft storage must meet side setback requirements of the Code at both ends of the combined sites.
- The length of the dock use area will be based on the shoreline of the combined sites.
