SUBJECT: 8/27/08 Board Planning/Workshop Session

At its June 25, 2008 meeting, the Lake Minnetonka Conservation District (LMCD) Board of Directors cancelled the Regular LMCD Board Meetings scheduled for August 13<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>. In their place, the LMCD has scheduled Board Workshop/Planning Sessions on Lake Minnetonka for August 13<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>.

Review of the Lower Lake is planned for the evening of August 27<sup>th</sup>, with the following details:

- **Location of Departure-** Transient dock on Excelsior Bay at the end of Water Street (east of the Excelsior Commons).
- **Time of Departure-** 6 p.m. with a planned completion time of 9 p.m.
- **Tentative Itinerary (not limited to)-** 1) 2008 Miles Canning dock installation (settled litigation), 2) Big Island Park property (City of Orono), 3) Cedar Point East channel (pending Quiet Water Area request), 4) Knight/Rolf residential sites (approved dock length and side setback variances), 5) Locust Hills Development (approved HOA multiple dock license), 6) viewing of 2008 herbicide treatment project on Grays Bay, 7) viewing of multiple dock license sites in Minnetonka Beach, 8) storage of houseboat along County 19 near Coffee Cove, and 9) Shorewood Yacht Club, Site 2 (approved minor change application for 10 canopies).
