ORDINANCE NO. 235

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAKE MINNETONKA CONSERVATION
DISTRICT CODE OF ORDINANCES TO COMPLY WITH LAWS OF MINNESOTA
2019, 1ST SPEC. SESS. CHAPTER 4, ARTICLE 3, SECTION 75

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LAKE MINNETONKA CONSERVATION
DISTRICT ORDAINS:

Article I. Scope of Regulations. Chapter I, Section 1.03 of the Lake Minnetonka Conservation District Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new Subd. 7 as follows and renumbering the subsequent subdivisions accordingly:


Subd. 7. Scope. This Code of Ordinance is enacted in accordance with the powers conveyed by Minnesota Statutes, sections 103B.601 through 103B.645, and such other authority as may exist. Nothing in this Code of Ordinance is intended to apply to public drainage ditches or watercourses connected to the Lake, or to land-based activities of commercial marinas occurring above the ordinary high-water mark of the Lake. However, the land-based facilities, services, and amenities of a commercial marina located above the high-water mark may be considered for purposes such as determining eligibility for a special density license.

Article II. Off-Lake Storage Facilities. Chapter II, Section 2.045 of the Lake Minnetonka Conservation District Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by deleting it in its entirety.

Article III. Declaration. This enactment is adopted by a majority vote of all the members of the Board, has the effect of an ordinance, and is in effect on the first day of publication after adoption.
