- The dock structure has a single point of entry from the shoreline.
- All of the combined sites have at least 20 feet of shoreline at elevation 929.4 NGVD.
- No more watercraft may be stored at the combined site than can be practically and validly stored at the uncombined sites including consideration of side setback requirements at the uncombined sites.

- The dock structure and watercraft storage must meet side setback requirements of the Code at both ends of the combined sites.
- The length of the dock use area will be based on the shoreline of the combined sites.

- Scaled drawing of the dock on the combined shoreline, including all boat storage units and other information required by the Executive Director.
