ORDINANCE NO. 241

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE LAKE MINNETONKA
CONSERVATION DISTRICT CODE OF ORDINANCES TO
EXPRESSLY PROHIBIT DELIVERIES ON THE LAKE

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE LAKE MINNETONKA CONSERVATION
DISTRICT ORDAINS:

Article I. Deliveries Prohibited. Article 8, Chapter 1, Section 8-1.11, Subd. 4 of the LMCD Code is hereby amended as follows:

Subd. 4. Commercial Sales on the Lake. It is unlawful for any person to sell or deliver food, beverages, supplies or other merchandise, products or goods as part of a commercial transaction, no matter how initiated, from any watercraft or vehicle on the Lake, except that food and beverages may be sold on a watercraft for hire that has a current certificate of registration from the LMCD.

Article II. Incorporation of Amendments. The LMCD Attorney is authorized to incorporate these amendments into the LMCD Code and is authorized to make such corrective changes as may be needed to correct formatting, maintain internal consistency, renumber sections, and as may otherwise be needed to implement the changes intended by this ordinance.


Article III. Declaration. This enactment is adopted by a majority vote of all the members of the Board, has the effect of an ordinance, and is in effect on the first day of publication after adoption.
