Classes are for youth 12 years and older and adults. Firsthand demonstrations will provide practical boating skills. Course presenters work with participants and share unique boating experiences and key on-board safety practices. Parents and guardians are encouraged to attend for a rewarding experience.

Participants must pass the exam to receive the Permit. For youth, the LMCD will reimburse the Permit fee upon request.
