The boating and recreational activities on Lake Minnetonka enjoyed an excellent summer season with continued high use by both residents and visitors to the Lake. Winter also brings a flurry of activities on the lake along with a beauty of its own. Like never before, the demand for time on the lake has elevated lake use to record levels. Increased traffic, variations in watercraft, and an unprecedented increase in watercraft registrations are undeniable factors in evaluating safety

To meet the **immediate demand for safety** during the summer of 2022, the Save The Lake Fund partnered with the Hennepin County Sheriff's Office (HCSO) to increase coverage for 2 additional summer deputies dedicated to shortening emergency response times and enforcing lake ordinances through education and citations when necessary. To assure this higher level of safety and to meet this immediate financial need to keep the lake safe, the Save The Lake fund agreed to general funding for HCSO for the 2023 boating season.

These **critical services** along with boater education, ice safety education, navigational enhancements, and other lake safety efforts are only **made possible by your generous financial gifts**.
