Classes are for youth 12 years and older and adults. Firsthand demonstrations will provide practical boating skills. Course presenters work with participants and share unique boating experiences and key on-board safety practices. Parents and guardians are encouraged to attend for a rewarding experience.

BEFORE CLASS:

- Set up your boater safety education course account at <https://cde.boaterexam.com/usa/minnesota/>. You will be required to pay the \$29.95 fee to set up the account.

BRING TO CLASS:

- Youth may bring a Parent/Guardian/Mentor (Recommended).
- Your Course Account information including **Username and Password** (for each person testing) to log into course materials and exam.
- An operable laptop or iPad with Google Chrome loaded to access internet-based curriculum and exam. Bring a charger and be sure you know the passwords to log in to the mobile device. Free Wi-Fi provided in class.
- Receipt of payment for reimbursement, only given out if the youth participant passes the course.
